RECYCLE YOUR CLEAN HOLIDAY SHIPPING BOXES!

Like many materials, cardboard is in high demand. Now more than ever, it is important to recycle your clean cardboard boxes. Tape and labels do not have to be removed. Remember to flatten boxes before placing them in the blue lid recycling cart.

Shipping materials, like bubble wrap and air pillows, do not belong in Orange County's blue lid recycling carts—please drop these items off at participating stores. For more information, visit www.PlasticFilmRecycling.org.



Did you know greeting cards with musical chips or glitter are not recyclable? Wrapping paper and aluminum baking pans shouldn't go in your blue lid recycling cart either!

Please place these items in your green lid garbage cart for regular disposal.

Christmas Trees

Live Christmas trees may be placed curbside on yard waste collection day. **Be sure to prepare your tree for pickup:** cut trees over six feet in half and remove the stand and decorations. Artificial trees that do not fit in the garbage cart can be set out for large item collection.

There will be no holiday interruptions to curbside collection!

Christmas and New Year's Day will not impact curbside collection. Please place your carts curbside by 6 a.m. on your regular collection day.

Before tossing old, unused electronic equipment in the garbage cart this holiday season, consider dropping it off at the Porter Transfer Station for free disposal and recycling. An item is considered electronic waste if it contains a circuit board, such as cell phones, tablets, computers, and stereos.
